

## Local Scenes Will Be Focus of Art Show

A nostalgic exhibition, "Cities and Villages: Buffalo and Western New York as Seen by Six Area Artists," will open Sunday in the Burchfield Center at Buffalo State College and continue through Nov. 8. The center is open 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesdays through Saturdays and 1 to 5 Sundays.

The exhibition includes Charles Burchfield's watercolor of Washington and Genesee streets, about 1930, and the old Broadway Market at Christmas time; Virginia Cuthbert's painting of the Niagara Street market; Robert Blair's "Concert at Kleinhans"; and a Tony Sisti composite of Allentown houses.

Other artists represented are Harold Olmsted, Esther Hoyt Sawyer and Claire Shuttleworth.
